Senior Breakfast is a great tradition and all seniors deserve congratulations for their accomplishments. Moreover, many community members give of their time and efforts to support West Perry students. Therefore, it would show them appreciation and respect if your dress, appearance and attitude were reflective of our school's expectations.

In order to participate in the graduation ceremony and baccalaureate, all seniors **must** adhere to the dress code. Boys must wear dress pants, dress shirt, dress shoes and tie. Girls must wear a dress or dress pants and dress shoes. A lightly colored dress is suggested – it does not need to be white. **No sneakers, flip flops, jeans, shorts, or capri pants, etc.**

Practice will be as long or as short as you make it. Your cooperation will speed up the process.

**If you do not come to graduation practices, you will not be able to participate in the graduation ceremony. Make all arrangements to ensure that you will be at the practices. These are considered school days for attendance purposes.**

Provided you do not have debt obligations to fulfill, diplomas will be distributed after the graduation ceremony. Graduates should report to the concession stand where tables will be set-up to distribute diplomas alphabetically. Honor graduates are to return their gold stoles to Mrs. Messner or Mrs. Hitzelberger. **This will only be open ½ hour after the ceremony.** After that you must pick-up your diploma at the high school office during normal business hours.

If you have family that require handicapped seating, you must notify Mrs. Messner prior to the day of the ceremony. Seating is not for the entire family, just the family member requiring the accommodation.
